Course Descriptions

April 2009—March 2010

● STD Part-Time Intensive (Introductory) 3-day course

Course Dates:

June 16-18, 2009
August 25-27, 2009
January 13-15, 2010
March 29-31, 2010

Tuition: \$60.00

This introductory clinical course covers the fundamentals of diagnosing, treating and preventing STDs. Participants will improve skills and gain practical experience through training in our STD clinic and stat laboratory, and traditional lecture presentations.

Eligibility: This course is intended for healthcare professionals who have very limited experience working with STD patients, generally less than six months.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course participants should be able to:

Review how to diagnose, treat, follow-up, counsel patients and manage sex partners for all priority and prevalent STDs including HIV infection.

Conduct a complete sexual history, develop skills in examining male and female patients and properly collect laboratory specimens.

Describe and Interpret the basic stat laboratory tests to aid in STD diagnosis.

Demonstrate the use of universal precautions during STD examinations.

● STD Intensive (Introductory) 5-day course

Course Date:

October 19-23, 2009

Tuition: \$100.00

This introductory clinical course is intended for healthcare professionals whose duties include managing patients with STDs. STD Intensive will provide in-depth information on the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of STDs. Participants will improve skills and gain practical experience through hands-on training in our STD clinic and stat laboratory, and lecture presentations.

Target Audience: Public health clinicians (physicians, physician assistants, advanced practice nurses, nurses) who work in STD clinics or spend the majority of their time managing patients with STDs. This course is also appropriate for clinicians who work in family planning, adolescent health and women's health clinics with one year of experience or more.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course participants should be able to:

Review how to diagnose, treat, follow-up, counsel patients and manage sex partners for all priority and prevalent STDs including HIV infection.

Conduct a thorough and accurate sexual history.

Perform and analyze a complete And accurate STD examination.

Collect and properly prepare laboratory specimens.

Describe and interpret the basic stat laboratory tests to aid in STD diagnosis.

Describe Client Centered Counseling and how it relates to patient counseling, follow-up, and management of sex partners including HIV.

● STD Advanced 5-day course

Course Dates:

September 14-18, 2009
February 22-26, 2010

Tuition: \$100.00

STD Advanced is designed for the clinician who has experience in diagnosing, treating and managing patients with STDs. This comprehensive course includes discussion of the complications and sequelae with special considerations for priority and prevalent STDs. Participants will improve skills and gain practical experience through hands-on training in our STD clinic and stat laboratory, and lecture presentations.

Target Audience: Applicants should have a minimum of 12 months of clinical experience managing patients with STDs.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course participants should be able to:

Discuss complications, sequelae and special considerations of priority and prevalent STDs including HIV infections.

Demonstrate improved skills in taking a complete sexual history. Perform male and female STD examinations and properly collect laboratory specimens.

Demonstrate improved skills in the differential diagnosis of STDs and identify atypical manifestations.

Explain how to refer patients with STD or HIV infection for additional medical intervention or additional healthcare.

Describe the complexity of working with adolescents.

Describe complications of patients with hepatitis.

● Update for Clinicians 2-day course

Course Dates:

This clinical course is intended to provide experienced clinicians with cutting edge information. Update for clinicians will cover the complex issues related to STDs and HIV. Challenges of managing STD patients will be discussed. Participants will gain experience in our STD clinic and stat laboratory.

Target Audience: Experienced public health and private practice clinicians and other health professionals whose job duties include managing patients with STDs.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course participants should be able to:

Discuss recent advances in the diagnosis, treatment and follow-up for all priority and prevalent STDs including HIV infection.

Describe the challenges of making an STD diagnosis.

Discuss the CDC Guidelines for STDs and what to do when treatment fails.

Describe the complications of STDs in pregnancy.
